ORDER FOR SUPERVISED POSSESSION BY HARRIS COUNTY DOMESTIC RELATIONS OFFICE

Pursuant to Section 153.004, Texas Family Code, the Court finds that credible evidence has been presented that _____ (hereinafter "the Parent") has engaged in conduct which constitutes a history or pattern of past or present child neglect, child abuse or family violence. The Court further finds that awarding the Parent possession of or access to the child(ren) through a supervised possession/access program: (1) would not endanger the child(ren)'s physical health or emotional welfare; (2) would be in the best interest of the child(ren); (3) protects the safety and well-being of the child(ren); and (4) protects others affected by the Parent's conduct.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Parent's visitation shall be under the supervision of the Harris County Domestic Relations Office Visitation Center ("The Visitation Center") as authorized by Section 153.014, Texas Family Code on the days and times, and under the terms and conditions prescribed by The Visitation Center. IT IS ORDERED that the Parent's supervised possession starts immediately and applies to all periods of possession occurring after the date the Court signs this Order.

IT IS ORDERED that _____ and _____ shall contact The Visitation Center, 1310 Prairie Street, Suite 1030, Houston, Texas 77002, (713) 274-7285 on or before _____, 20__ to schedule an intake interview for the Parent's supervised visitation services. Each party is ORDERED to attend his or her intake interview at the date, time, and place scheduled by The Visitation Center, and to provide such documentation as is requested by The Visitation Center at the intake interview.

IT IS ORDERED that immediately upon completion of the intake interview (select one):
___ each party is responsible for payment of their annual registration fee; or
___ the Parent shall be responsible for payment of each party's annual registration fees.
In addition, the Parent shall be responsible for payment of all fees for each visit in accordance with the rules and policies of The Visitation Center.
